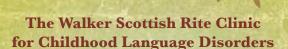


## **Mission**

The Walker Scottish Rite Clinic's Giving Tree program was established in 1997 to help provide funding to support speech and language therapy at the Clinic. The Giving Tree, located in the St. Louis Clinic, is seen by dozens of people every day as families come and go for speech and language therapy. The Giving Tree will be transplanted when the Clinic moves to Maryville University in 2014.

Each leaf on the tree honors a person or event, provides a lasting memorial to a loved one, or is the name of a person loyal to the Clinic.
