CLINIC SERVICES

The Walker Scottish Rite Clinic provides free services to children ages two through six years with communication disorders. The goal of the Clinic is to reach children who do not receive the help they need elsewhere. Each child who enters the Clinic's program is screened, evaluated and treated by one of the Clinic's eight Masters level speech and language pathologists who are certified by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) and the Hanen Centre, as well as being licensed by the Missouri State Board of Healing Arts.

Services are provided at two locations in the greater St. Louis area, including the main site on Olive Street, one St. Louis City Head Start, as well as three outlying sites in Crystal City, Elsberry and Union. The Clinic also focuses on community screenings at area daycares and preschools as well as coordinated outreach events.

Individual therapy sessions are tailored to meet each child's particular needs. Group therapy is also available as a supplement. Parents are vital in continuing the carryover treatment at home, they receive parent education instruction, observe their child in therapy, and learn techniques they can use with their child at home.
